**REF: TAXATION REVIEW 2013 – 2015:**

This submission concerns the most unprivileged individuals or business organization internally. The Internal Revenue Commission is doing well, but has yet to accomplish 100% working system. The government of PNG should not be bias by allowing Tax Exemptions to anybody or organization whether it be newly established or what so ever. This makes unfair for many of the local business that are newly registered. If the IRC like, they can give the Tax Exemptions period of 3 years to everyone being newly registered with IPA. After 3 year every registered list with IPA should pay tax according to each ones profitable margin. Every business entity should pay Tax no matter what. However, the IRC should encourage those business along the chain of exporting crops of the majority of the population are working on their land to produce the crop which will bring in Revenue from outside of PNG.

Secondly, the majority of people will be encouraged to work on their land and grow more of the crop for the benefit or their own family and the country. It is of this reason that the IRC should provided some kind of credit scheme for farmers or growers on the land. One such a system to encourage business and farms or individual is that, the Government through IRC and IPA to approve all kind or type of CLAIMS by business organization or individual. That is the business must be registered and must have a Tax file and must be a tax payer or have track record with IRC before any claims should be approved.

Otherwise, everyone organization must fulfill these requirements with IRC and some controlling institution such as IPA, and such as for coffee companies with CIC and Timber Companies with Forestry or farms with Agriculture Dept or Fishery etc. Approval must be given by these institutions instead of politicians because politics spoil the soup and so much money is being paid out by such Finance and National Planning Departments on such crapulous claims.
